GDPR: DATA PRIVACY NOTICE FOR EMPLOYEES, WORKERS OR CONTRACTORS

1. Why have you been given this privacy notice?

Lagoon Watersports is a "data controller". This means that we are required under data protection legislation to notify you of how we will process your personal data both during the employment relationship and post termination. - Kept in a form which permits you to be identified for only as long as necessary for the purposes we have told you about.
- Kept securely.

 - Your name, salutation, addresses, contact numbers, and personal email addresses.
 - Date of birth.
 - Gender.
